- Include a recommendation letter written by one of your High School teachers or coaches.
- Submit a list of all extracurricular activities or work history
- Finalists are asked to attend Shelby Energy Cooperative's Annual Meeting in June where they will be recognized for participating in the Washington Youth Tour.

All Applications must be submitted to the Shelby Energy office by February 11, 2019 by 4:30 pm.

(Semi–Finalists will be chosen to attend the Frankfort VIP Youth Tour in March. Finalists to attend Washington Youth Tour will be notified following the Frankfort Youth Tour.)
