

Your Safety Matters

Be alert to danger when using space heaters

Recently, a Florida family lost their home to a fire caused by placing a space heater too close to a bed.



Everyone, including the family's pets, survived that fire, but not everyone is so fortunate.

The National Fire Protection Association reported that over 85 percent of all home fire injuries or deaths occurred because of the improper use or malfunction of a space heater over the last few years.

To ensure your safety when using a space heater, always take proper safety precautions:

■ Keep all flammable items at least three feet away from the heater at all times.

- Never toss bedding or clothing on or near the space heater.
- Prevent overheating by plugging the heater directly into the wall outlet instead of using an extension cord.
- Turn the space heater off before you go to bed or leave the house. It is much safer to layer with blankets and warm clothing than risk a fire sparking while you sleep.
- Keep children and pets away from the heater at all times. Even the slightest contact with a heating coil can cause severe burns.
